■ SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Before you submit your abstract, please register on the submission system, EasyChair.

The abstract should be written in English and include:

- 300-400 words (not including references)
- 3-5 keywords
- 3-5 bibliographical references

The best paper from each strand (chosen by the Strand Chair) will be published in a special issue of the academic journal, Intercultural Education. There are also plans to publish the abstracts in conference proceedings for each strand.
